FB MEMBERSHIP

JFB DUTIES:

A member will be required:

- to attend monthly meetings
- to help run JFB sponsored fair activities
- to aid at least one other fair department as a volunteer
- to support all JFB planned activities, including, workdays, fundraising and social events

ADVISORS:

Adult Advisors are appointed by the Fair CEO to direct members in **all activities**. Through this direction, members will learn leadership and job skills in a safe environment. No member will be expected to do a job without full advisor support.

RULES OF CONDUCT:

Advisors and Members are expected to adhere to a set of code of conduct at all times on the fairgrounds, at any other JFB function, and/or while wearing the JFB uniform. The code of conduct is described in the JFB by-laws and is equivalent to FFA and 4-H codes.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must be between the age of 13 and 19
- The JFB has twenty-five positions, therefore members are chosen through an interview process.
- Applicants do not have to belong to any other youth organization.

Entry due date: Every Saturday and Sunday in August
Entry pick-up date: September 20, 2010. 9 am - 5 pm
Drop off and pick-up at: Mr. Magorium's Exploritorium

Rules:

1. Displays must be interactive or at least 3 dimensional. No posters. For poster entries see Youth Department.
2. There is a maximum size of 5'x5'and 7' in height.
3. There can be no chemicals or live animals in display. The Junior Fair Board retains the right to reject an entry that may cause a threat to public safety.
4. Displays must be built to withstand an average of 2000 fairgoers each day or to be built within an enclosure provided by the entrant.
5. All entrants must provide their own stand or table. Electricity is provided by the Junior Fair Board.
6. Neither the Junior Fair Board nor the Fairgrounds is responsible for breakage of the display through normal fair interaction.

Judging Criteria: Educational value (20%), Durability (20%), Interactiveness (20%), Title (10%), Attractibility (10%), Information Accuracy (10%), Uniqueness (10%).

Awards: There will be awarded a \$100 prize to the Best of Show per each Class (bases on age). 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded thereafter. In addition, there will be a prize (to be determined) for best display entered as judged by public opinion.

Fee: \$1 per entry.
