



Quick Tips for Livestock 2021

We are now accepting online entries for Livestock – entry deadline is August 28, 2021. Due to limited pen space, breeding, feeder and carcass contest divisions will remain closed until August 7, 2021. See Pen Space in the entry guide.

Required Documents for Exhibitors – may be uploaded via the online entry system. Forms can be found in the entry guide. All documentation is due by entry deadline.

*Submit only one Release of Liability and one Exhibitor Eligibility per exhibitor.

Original Bills of sale, proof of ownership, animal medication (dated no more than 3 days before the fair opens) and/or registration documents are required at Check-In.

Entry Fees

Entry fees will be charged for all non-market animals this year. See entry guide for specific fees. An animal will only be charged once – there will be no entry fees for groups of animals or showmanship.

Mandatory Exhibitor Training

All exhibitors of cattle, swine, sheep, goats or meat rabbits must sign up for and complete the online YQCA Certification Program available at yqca.org no later than August 28, 2021.

YQCA certification is valid for one year and is used by most fairs throughout the state of California. If your current certification is valid through at least September 19, 2021, you do not

have to renew your certification. Your certification number will be requested when you create your user account in ShoWorks.

Still Exhibits

Youth Livestock Exhibitors of **market animals** (beef, hogs, lambs, goats) are required to enter a non-perishable Still Exhibit in a non-livestock department at the Santa Cruz County Fair. Livestock Educational Displays do not satisfy this requirement. Entries must be recorded in the **Main Fair** online system by August 26, 2021, and must be delivered to the fairgrounds according to established receiving schedules. Exhibitors failing to enter and bring their still exhibits to the fairgrounds by the receiving dates as published in the Official Entry Guide, will not be allowed to weigh-in or show their market animals at the fair. Wristbands and Camping Department.

Exhibitors in all livestock departments except for Rabbits, Poultry, Pygmy Goats and Educational Displays are required to wear an Exhibitor Wristband at all times during the fair. Exhibitor wristbands must be requested by submitting an online entry in the ***Wristbands and Camping* Department, 01-Exhibitor Wristband Division**, by the entry deadline of August 28, 2021. Wristbands for Junior Livestock Exhibitor and Carcass exhibitors under 18 are \$35. Wristbands for Open Carcass Contest exhibitors aged 18 and older are \$50. All entries for exhibitors who do not have a wristband request entry in the system after August 28 will be cancelled.

Parents/Siblings may request up to two wristbands per family by adding entries to your livestock exhibitor's account for \$50 each. Use ***Wristbands and Camping* Department, 100-Livestock Parent/Sibling Wristband Division**. Do not create an account for parents unless they are exhibiting livestock.

Leaders and advisors may request wristbands by creating an individual online account and submitting an entry in the ***Wristbands and Camping* Department, 200-Livestock Leader Wristband Division**. Cost is \$50. Paper supporting documents required. Form is available in the entry guide or at the link provided in the online system.

Camping spots will be allotted via lottery this year due to limited space in the area. Paper forms must be submitted by August 28, 2021. See form in entry guide.
