RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Classes will be guided by USEF Rules & Regulations. (PLEASE NOTE NEW COVID 19 REGULATIONS)**
 - a. **FACEMASKS WILL BE REQUIRED PER CURRENT STATE AND CDC GUIDELINES**
 - b. **PRE-ENTRY WILL BE REQUIRED TO MINIMIZE THE TRAFFIC IN THE SHOW OFFICE**
2. **TIME SCHEDULE:** Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class at its discretion in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management also reserves the right to cancel or combine any class having less than three (3) entries. Time schedules & order of classes are subject to change after the close of entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check the time schedule.
3. **Stalls** and Tack Rooms will be available. \$150 fee. **Bedding not included.** Please call Country Hills Feed (831) 722-6588 for delivery of bedding and feed. \$40 per day haul-in fee if you are not boarding in a stall.
4. **Courses** will consist of any of the following combinations: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post/Rails, Coops, & Walls.
5. **Conflicts:** It is the intention of Management to avoid holding rings to wait for horses &/or riders. Exhibitors with conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so they will not delay a class. **We will be enforcing a one (1) minute gate call.**
6. **Dogs** and all other pets must be leashed and in the control of a competent person at all times.
7. **Returned Check Fee:** \$25.00 Returned Check Charge. No personal checks accepted for payment of returned checks.
8. **Attire: Protective headgear is always mandatory for ALL riders , whether showing or schooling.**
9. **Full Payment** must accompany entries along with a **Signed Release of Liability. (NO EXCEPTIONS!!!)**
10. **All trainers and riders must leave an open check upon registration for any add/drop changes and incidentals incurred throughout the show. (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

- Jumpers:** All Jumper Tables may be used.
- Hunters:** To be judged on performance & soundness. Emphasizing manners; penalizing extreme speed.
- Equitation:** To be judged on hands, seat, & horsemanship. Individual work will be at Judge's discretion.
- Walk Trot:** If rider cross enters out of Walk Trot Div., or Ground Rails Div., rider is ineligible for Champion or Reserve Champion in Walk Trot Div.
- Lead Line:** Rider may not enter in any other classes except for Classes # 67, 68, 69
- Walk Only:** Rider may only cross enter into Lead Line.
- Maiden:** Not to have won more than one blue ribbon at any horse show
- Novice:** Not to have won more than 3 blue ribbons at any horse show

SPECIAL CLASSES

- Class #28 - \$5.00 Dollar Bill Bareback Special** – Bareback riding. Place \$5.00 bill under your leg. Last two riders that hold on to their \$5.00 bill are winners! All entries split 1st place – 60%, 2nd place 40%. **Entry fee is your \$5.00!**
- CLASS 112A, 112B, 112C-Special Equitation Challenge – Four Phases – Phase 1 – written quiz handed out in the show office. Must be turned in by 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 17. Phase 2 – Class 112C – Over Fences 2'3" – 2'9" (same fence height that horse and rider are currently showing). Phase 3 – Class 112B – Gymnastics, Phase 4 – Class 40A – Special Equitation Challenge on the Flat . Championship is total of accumulated points from all classes plus the written test. \$60 TOTAL –ALL 4 PHASES.**
- Class #200 - Versatility (In Western/Out English):** After performing on the rail in **Western** attire, riders will line up for review. Upon an audible signal, riders will have exactly 8 minutes; change into English attire & tack. Each entry may have two handlers to assist with tack change. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).
- Class #201 – Hunter Under Saddle Championship – Must have 5 entries prior to \$100 prize money being awarded.** Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).
- Class #202 – Hunt Seat Equitation on the Flat Championship** - Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).

Class #205 - \$250 "Wild Card" Gambler's Choice: To be shown over a course of 10 obstacles 3' to 3'3". Each obstacle will have a point value. Each rider will be allowed 50 seconds in which to accumulate as many points as possible after crossing (in either direction) the starting & finishing line. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only, either direction. After crossing the finishing line, each competitor will have the option of attempting, within 25 seconds, the **Joker Obstacle** which will have a point value of **200. JOKER FENCE WILL BE SET AT 3'6"**! Time will decide in the event of a tie Embroidered Saddle pad given to first place. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th place. **Must have 5 entries prior to \$250 prize money being awarded.** \$500 prize money split between top 5 1st-40%, 2nd-30%, 3rd- 15%, 4th 10%, 5th-5% . **(Entry Fee - \$40). Horse, but not rider, may cross enter Class #205 (\$100 Child/Adult Mini Gambler's Choice).**

Class #206 - \$100 Child/Adult Mini Gambler's Choice: To be shown over a course of 10 obstacles 2'6" to 2'9". Each obstacle will have a numerical point value. Each competitor will be allowed 50 seconds in which to accumulate as many points as possible after crossing (in either direction) the starting & finishing line. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only, either direction. After crossing the finish line, each competitor will have the option of attempting, within 25 seconds, the **Joker Obstacle** which will have a point value of **200. JOKER FENCE WILL BE SET AT 2'9"**! Time will decide in the event of a tie. Embroidered Saddle pad given to first place. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **Must have 5 entries prior to \$100 prize money being awarded.** \$100 prize money split between top 5. prize money split between top 5 1st-40%, 2nd-30%, 3rd- 15%, 4th 10%, 5th-5%. **(Entry Fee - \$40). Horse, but not rider may cross enter Class #205 (\$250 "Wild Card" Gambler's Choice).**

Class #208 - MINI Teams of 2/Relay(UP TO 2'-2'3"): Team will consist of 2 Riders/1 Horse. Riders may compete on multiple teams. Horses only go 1 time. First Rider goes through start line & time starts. Rider jumps a course of 6 fences & goes to designated area. Second rider mounts the horse & jumps the second half of the course & goes through the finish line where time stops. Rider must mount/dismount in designated area or be penalized with 30 seconds added to teams final time. Refusals and rails will be penalized by time adding **5 seconds** for each instance, each rider may have 3 stops before elimination. Winner is the team with the fastest time & least faults (rails down). Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **(Entry Fee - \$40 per team).**

Class #203 - Pairs Jumpers(UP TO 2'6" OPEN) (Entry Fee - \$40 per team) Team of two horses and two riders. Each horse and rider jumps their own course and then must jump the last fence together. 2'6" – Fastest clean round wins. Rider may compete on multiple teams but must change one rider. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th

Class #203 - MINI Pairs Jumpers (2'-2'3") (Entry Fee - \$40 per team) Team of two horses and two riders. Each horse and rider jumps their own course and then must jump the last fence together. 2'-2'3" – Fastest clean round wins. Rider may compete on multiple teams but must change one rider. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th

Class #207 - Teams of 2/Relay (UP TO 2'6" OPEN): ") Team will consist of 2 Riders/1 Horse. Riders may compete on multiple teams. Horses only go 1 time. First Rider goes through start line & time starts. Rider jumps a course of 6 fences & goes to designated area. Second rider mounts the horse & jumps the second half of the course & goes through the finish line where time stops. Rider must mount/dismount in designated area or be penalized with 30 seconds added to teams final time. Refusals and rails will be penalized by time adding **5 seconds** for each instance, each rider may have 3 stops before elimination. Winner is the team with the fastest time & least faults (rails down). . Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **(Entry Fee - \$40 per team).**

CLASS #161-Paso Robles Horse Park Green Rider Medal: Hosted at both the Park Schooling Show Series and the Paso Robles Horse Park USEF B-Rated Show Series, the PRHP Green Rider Medal features fences not to exceed 2'3" in height. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Tests may include USEF medal tests 1-6 and 10-13. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights above 3'. Finals of the 2019 Green Rider Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump show. Points from the final Schooling Show of the previous year, the first three schooling shows of the current year and the B-Rated shows of the current year are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the Green Rider Medal Final

CLASS #144-Paso Robles Horse Park Medal: Hosted at both the Park Schooling Show Series and the Park USEF B-Rated Show Series, the PRHP Medal features fences not to exceed 3' in height. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Tests may include USEF medal tests 1-17. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders. Finals of the 2019 PRHP Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump show. Points from the final Schooling Show of the previous year, the first three schooling shows of the current year and the B-Rated shows of the current year are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the PRHP Medal Final.

CLASS #172-Cloverleaf Medal Open to junior and amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'7". To be judged over a jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control of the horse on

a jumper type of ride. There will not be a time allowed, a tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties will be considered in accordance with USEF equitation rules. Additional work offs after the initial round will be at the judges discretion and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter and compete in the class. First and second place will qualify for the finals. Points awarded 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. Winner of the medal final class will receive a golf cart and a cooler. Prizes to 10th in the finals.

OCEAN BREEZE 2'6" MEDAL Hosted twice during the June and August Ocean Breeze Hunter/Jumper shows. The Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal will consist of a hunter course set no higher than 2'6". Fences can be any combination of: . Obstacles must simulate those found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, hedge, natural foliage, straw, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, logs, etc. At least three of the following: 1. Bending Line 2. Narrow Jump (5'6"-8') 3. Roll back turn 4. Fence at the end of the ring 5. Long approach to a single jump. Verticals may be built with or without ground lines. They may be jumped in either direction, provided ground lines are correct (i.e. no false ground lines). A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Work off will be a course design of the riders choosing and can include USEF Medal Tests 1-12. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights above 3'. Finals of the 2021 Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal will be held at the September Ocean Breeze Show during the Santa Cruz County Fair. Points from the current year (2021) Ocean Breeze qualifiers are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 4 points or more are invited to participate in the Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal Final. Medal Finals in September will be two parts and over fences portion followed by a flat class top four to work off. Winners will be chosen by combined scores.

OCEAN BREEZE 2' MINI MEDAL Hosted twice during the June and August Ocean Breeze Hunter/Jumper shows. The Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal will consist of a hunter course set no higher than 2'. Fences can be any combination of: . Obstacles must simulate those found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, hedge, natural foliage, straw, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, logs, etc. At least three of the following: 1. Bending Line 2. Narrow Jump (5'6"-8') 3. Roll back turn 4. Fence at the end of the ring 5. Long approach to a single jump. Verticals may be built with or without ground lines. They may be jumped in either direction, provided ground lines are correct (i.e. no false ground lines). A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Work off will be a course design of the riders choosing and can include USEF Medal Tests 1-12. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights 2'6" or above. Finals of the 2021 Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal will be held at the September Ocean Breeze Show during the Santa Cruz County Fair. Points from the current year (2021) Ocean Breeze qualifiers are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 4 points or more are invited to participate in the Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal Final. Medal Finals in September will be two parts and over fences portion followed by a flat class top four to work off.
