OPTIONS FOR BUYERS

CUSTOM PROCESSING: If you want to have the animal(s) you purchased cut and wrapped for your consumption, choose this option. Check out the information on the right.

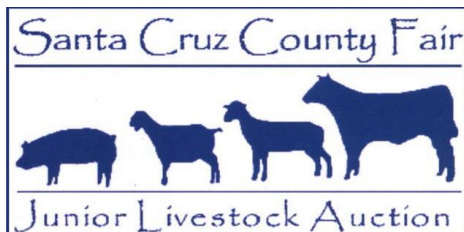
RESALE: If you want to help out the 4-H, FFA, Grange and independent exhibitors but have no need for the meat, the Auction Buyers' Committee will resell the animal at market price. You pay only the difference between the sale price and the current market price.

LIVE PICK UP: You may take your lamb, goat or hog purchases animal(s) home live if they are not champions. Animals must be picked up on Sunday, September 18, between 5:30 and 7:00 pm.

DONATION: If you do not wish to purchase an animal, you may still make a donation to the Auction Buyers' Committee (checks payable to SC County Fairgrounds Foundation). Donated funds will be used to purchase animals, which will then be resold. You may also opt to donate the meat to your favorite charity. (You handle the delivery.)

ADD ON: You may support our youth by designating a dollar amount to be added to their sale without purchasing their animal. Add-ons can be made in person or online by registering as a buyer.

CAN'T BE THERE?: Place an order with the Jr. Livestock Auction Buyers' Committee by sending an email to: santacruzlivestockcommittee@gmail.com. The committee will bid on an animal at your stipulated price. The animal will be sent to your designated meat locker (you must place the packaging order), or you can choose to have the animal resold at market price.
