BACKGROUND

Kelly is a special needs youth, and requires an annual approval to continue in the 4-H program beyond the age of 19. She must remain a member in good standing in a 4-H club and have the county 4-H office approval; the board motion for approval would then be forwarded to Tomme Jo Dale at F&E so that F&E can approve then grant the variance. Having the board approval and the variance from F&E will help in case of a protest.

Dear Sirs,

I have been approached by special needs member Kelly Thorp's mother Nancy, to extend Kelly's 4-H membership this year beyond the age of 19.

State 4-H policy states "Special needs youth are to enroll in the program based on their chronological age and follow the 4-H Youth Development Program age requirements of 5-19 years of age. Any extensions beyond the age of 19 of special needs youth must be approved annually by the county director."

I have made the decision to grant Kelly an extension this year, based on her love of the program, mastery of the skills she has developed and the relationships she has built. Kelly has enrolled in four livestock projects and five non-livestock projects this year.

I urge you to consider allowing her an (age) exception due to her developmental limitations to show at the fairs with her livestock projects in order to get the full 4-H/fair experience. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me.
