for a General ABC Alcohol Permit

## Request:

The Santa Cruz County Fair Board of Directors, as representatives of the State of California, acknowledge their awareness that the Santa Cruz County Fair Heritage Foundation sells alcohol on the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds and their desire to see the Foundation receive a #47 On-Sale General license to sell beer, wine and hard liquor on the Fairgrounds.

#47 ABC Permit grants us the privilege of selling beer, wine and hard liquor to the general public on state property and allows minors to be present on the premises. This permit is non-transferable.

We would appreciate your approval at your August 25, 2015 board meeting.

Timeframe: approximately 90 days after application is submitted

## Background:

Currently the Heritage Foundation obtains an ABC license for each event at the Fairgrounds where beer, wine and/or hard liquor is sold. This requires staff time to generate the paperwork and write individual checks, and the time to obtain the ABC permit, often causing Richard Travis to drive to Salinas for the permit.

Costs: ABC #47 Permit:

\$6,000 one-time fee

Legal advice and application preparation: \$2,000

Background checks of Heritage Board Members: \$192

Annual fees: \$292 for one fixed bar

\$292/portable bar selling hard liquor

## Financial Justification:

Total cost in 2014 was \$3,529.95 Total cost Jan - June, 2015 was \$1,975.00 Payback in 2 years
