### **TRANSFER OF REGULATORY OVERSIGHT - SANTA CRUZ COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS WATER SYSTEM (SYSTEM NO. 4400725)**

Per Section 1.04 in the Local Primacy Delegation Agreement between Santa Cruz Environmental Health and the State Water Resources Control Board – Division of Drinking Water (Division), dated December 13, 2013, small public water systems shall be directly regulated by the Division and are not subject to the delegation granted by the Agreement if they are owned and operated by agencies of the State of California. The Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds water system is owned by the 14<sup>th</sup> District Agricultural Association, which is a State of California agency.

Therefore, effective immediately, the Santa Cruz County Environmental Health Department has transferred the responsibility for regulatory oversight to the State Water Resources Control Board – Division of Drinking Water.

#### ***Billing Information***

The Division annually bills all small water systems at the beginning of each fiscal year (July 1 thru June 30), with fees based on the public water system type. The Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds water system has been classified as a non-transient non-community water system by Santa Cruz County Environmental Health.

The annual fees billed by the Division for this type of public water system is currently \$2 per person served but not less than \$456 annually. In addition, the system will be charged hourly for any Division time spent on enforcement for violations of state and federal regulations.

#### ***Requested Documentation***

Following receipt and review of files obtained from the Santa Cruz County Environmental Health Department, the Division will send a letter detailing requirements and necessary documentation required by the Division.

In the meantime, the Division requests the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds to provide the following documentation to the Division:


1. A completed Emergency Notification Plan (ENP) with your contact information. A blank form can be found in Attachment A of this letter. The ENP provides you with the Division's emergency contact information and provides the Division with your emergency contact information, which can be used in the event of an emergency. Please include contact information for water system management, water quality, and operations contact.
2. A completed Water System Classification worksheet, which can be found in Attachment B of this letter.
3. A completed Water System Contact Information Form, which can be found in Attachment C of this letter.

Please send the requested documentation to the Division by **October 25, 2015**.
