

Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds Camping Policy

General Camping Rules

Camping reservations will be taken in the Administration Office on a first-come-first-served basis.

All campers must complete a Camping Reservation Form and prepay before occupying their assigned space.

All rents must be prepaid for the planned duration of the stay before the site is occupied

Check in & check out time is 12 noon.

Reservations and space assignments for contracted special events such as equestrian shows, RV groups, church camps, etc are arranged through the event organizers. Special event camping shall have priority over nonevent camping.

Dry camping & tent camping is only allowed during special events.

2 (two) vehicles per site included in site fee. \$10 per day charge for extra vehicles.

All vehicles must be “street legal” and fully operational. No junk!

Extra vehicles & visitors must park in areas designated by management.

4 (four) occupants per site included in site fee. \$5 per day extra charge for additional occupants.

1 (one) pet – dog or cat - per site included in site fees. \$3 per day charge for extra pets.

Pets must be on leashes at all times. Pet waste must be cleaned up daily.

Campers are responsible for their pets & their pet’s welfare at all times.

Place trash in cans or the RV Park dumpster. Do not leave bags of trash on the ground.

Large groups (more than 2) of visitors must check in at office or receive prior permission to enter campgrounds.

Campgrounds are “quiet zones”. Please - No excessive noise at any time.

All sites must be kept neat & tidy. All supplies, equipment, and other possessions must be stored inside RV.

Length of Stay -

Between October 15th and April 15th (winter season)

Campers will be allowed to stay a maximum of 14 days & must be out 30 days before returning Unless previously arranged.

All campers wishing to stay longer than 14 days must fill out an application & be reviewed / approved by the CEO, and sign a monthly contract before move in. The monthly contracts will be reviewed by the CEO prior to renewal.

Between April 15th and October 15 (summer season)

Campers will be allowed to stay a maximum of 14 days & must be out 30 days before returning Unless previously arranged.

Fairgrounds management may consider allowing longer term RV space rentals depending on availability & circumstance. Campers must apply & be reviewed / approved by the CEO, Pre pay monthly rent in full and sign a monthly contract before move in. The monthly contracts will be reviewed by the CEO prior to renewal.
