

## Santa Cruz County Fair 2019 - Local Horse Show Rules

1. All classes are extended classes; open to the world, unless otherwise noted.
2. No entry form will be accepted unless the exhibitor or his agents sign it. **Completed RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT must accompany all entry forms.** Checks for Entry Fees, Drug Fee and Stall Rents MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. **Entry deadlines vary. Check show information.**
3. Refunds will be made only with a Veterinarian's Certificate that the animal may not be shown for health reasons. For substitutions, see State Rules. **MUST BE PRESENTED IN WRITING PRIOR TO ENTERED CLASS.** No refunds after September 11, 2019.
4. Substitutions for exhibitors not able to show can only be made 24 hours prior to day of show. Request for substitutions **MUST BE** in writing, and submitted to the show secretary. There is a \$5.00 fee for each name substitution. Fee **MUST** accompany the written request form.
5. The Santa Cruz County Fair shall not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by a horse exhibited at the show and exhibitor shall not hold the Santa Cruz County Fair responsible. Although doing all in its power to protect exhibitors, the Santa Cruz County Fair will not in any case hold itself responsible for any loss or damage to the horses exhibited at the show, or for the loss or damage to any vehicle or article belonging to the exhibitor or employees.
6. Exhibitors of horses are warned that ANY discourtesy, swearing, cursing or being verbally abusive in the arena or in the horse show area (stands or grounds), to any official, judge, worker, or spectator, or ANY disobedience of rules on the part of the owner, trainer, groom, rider, parents, guardians, or immediate family, shall disqualify the horse and rider and the owner will forfeit his/her winnings. The Santa Cruz County Fair reserves to itself the power to remove any owner, trainer, rider, groom, or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
7. A limited number of box stalls are available on the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. The stall fee is \$25.00 per day/night. Please indicate date and time of arrival, number of stalls needed, and when departing, on the entry form.
8. No dry camping will be available this year. No exceptions.
9. State Rules are posted in the Horse Show Office and may be requested for view by any exhibitor.
10. **PROTEST:** see State Rule V.

#### TRAILERING HORSE:

**Driver and one (1) passenger trailering horse(s) will be free.** Additional persons in vehicle or guest(s) in separate vehicle(s) will pay gate fee. (This includes riders not pre-entered in the show).

\*\*\*NOTE: Horse show exhibitors may purchase a multiple day pass at the horse show office.

#### PARKING:

Cars and trucks not attached to trailers will park in designated parking areas only. Trailers must be moved to the designated Upper Trailer Parking area after unloading. Any vehicles parked illegally will be towed away at owner's expense.

#### DROP OFFS:

Once you drop off a person or an item please park in designated area. If you need heavy items transported to a certain area, please do not hesitate to have gate person call either the horse show or livestock office to provide adequate transportation. **NO obstruction in any NO PARKING or FIRE LANE area will be allowed.** This will be strictly enforced, per Fire Marshall.
